Dramatic Circle, Hyderabad (DCH), the only English theatre group in twin cities, on completion of 20 years of its inception is celebrating the occasion with the staging of Girish Karnad's English play 'Tughlaq' at 7 p.m. on March 8 and 9 at the Hyderabad Public School, according to a Press release.

The Dramatic Circle, founded in early 1960 was so far brought to the theatre loving public of Hyderabad and Secunderabad comedies of Shakespeare, Wilde, Coward and Philip King, serious plays like 'A Man for All', 'Seasons and Oedipus Rex', plays of the Theatre of the Absurd by 'Ionesco and Arrabal' and Indian plays translated into English such as Mohan Rakesh's 'A Day in Ashad', Vijay Tendulkar's 'Silence' and Girish Karnad's 'Hayavadana'.

Girish Karnad's Tughlaq, which is going to be staged tomorrow is directed by Dr. M. Nagabhushana Sarma.
